



EducAid Code of Conduct

EducAid aims to ensure respect for, and fulfilment of, international human rights standards for all, including those enshrined in the Convention on the Rights of the Child and the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women.

EducAid has a duty of care to beneficiaries, and a responsibility to ensure that they are treated with dignity and respect and that certain minimum standards of conduct are observed.

EducAid aims to create environments free of sexual exploitation and abuse in all contexts, through implementing appropriate prevention and response mechanisms and ensuring that breaches in the code of conduct are not tolerated:

- I will not have a sexual or exclusive relationship with any young person under the age of 18 years of age.
- I will not have a sexual or exclusive relationship with any student in the school, of whatever age.
- I will not be alone with a student or young person under 18 years of age in a vehicle or house.
- I will not give or lend money to a student.
- I will not visit students' homes without explicit permission of the site coordinator.
- I will not allow any student into my room.
- I will not engage in any activity, which will reflect badly upon the school.
- I will not engage in any private tuition of students without prior notification of the Country Director.
- I will not engage in any private tuition of EducAid students at all.
- I will not engage in any money-making activities involving EducAid students.
- I will do all in my power to build an environment where sexual exploitation and abuse is not allowed or tolerated.
- I will not tolerate or ignore any breaches of the code of conduct that I become aware of. I will report any breaches of the code of conduct that I become aware of.
